

SIZE GUIDE

Rings

Please take your measurement correctly. In case of mistake on your part, an exchange is possible, but the shipping costs will be at your expense.

KNOW YOUR SIZE

Some advice:

If you hesitate between two sizes, we recommend that you choose the larger one. The fingers may be more "swollen" at certain times, for example at the end of the day or in summer. Also, for your comfort, it is better to wear a ring that is a little big than too small.

Important: we draw your attention to the fact that the width of the ring (its band) influences the size to be chosen: the wider a ring, the greater the size.

We propose below 3 methods to know your size.

METHOD 1

Measure a thin, round (non-adjustable) ring that you currently wear on the destined finger for the new piece of jewelry you wish to acquire.

You can also measure your finger size directly with your jeweler.

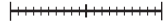
Please note that the finger sizes may be different in the right hand and the left hand.

This method is the most reliable one compared to the following two.

METHOD 2

1. For a reliable result, print this document in A4 format and in real size (scale 100%) To make sure it was printed correctly, please check the scale below using a ruler. It should measure exactly 2 cm.

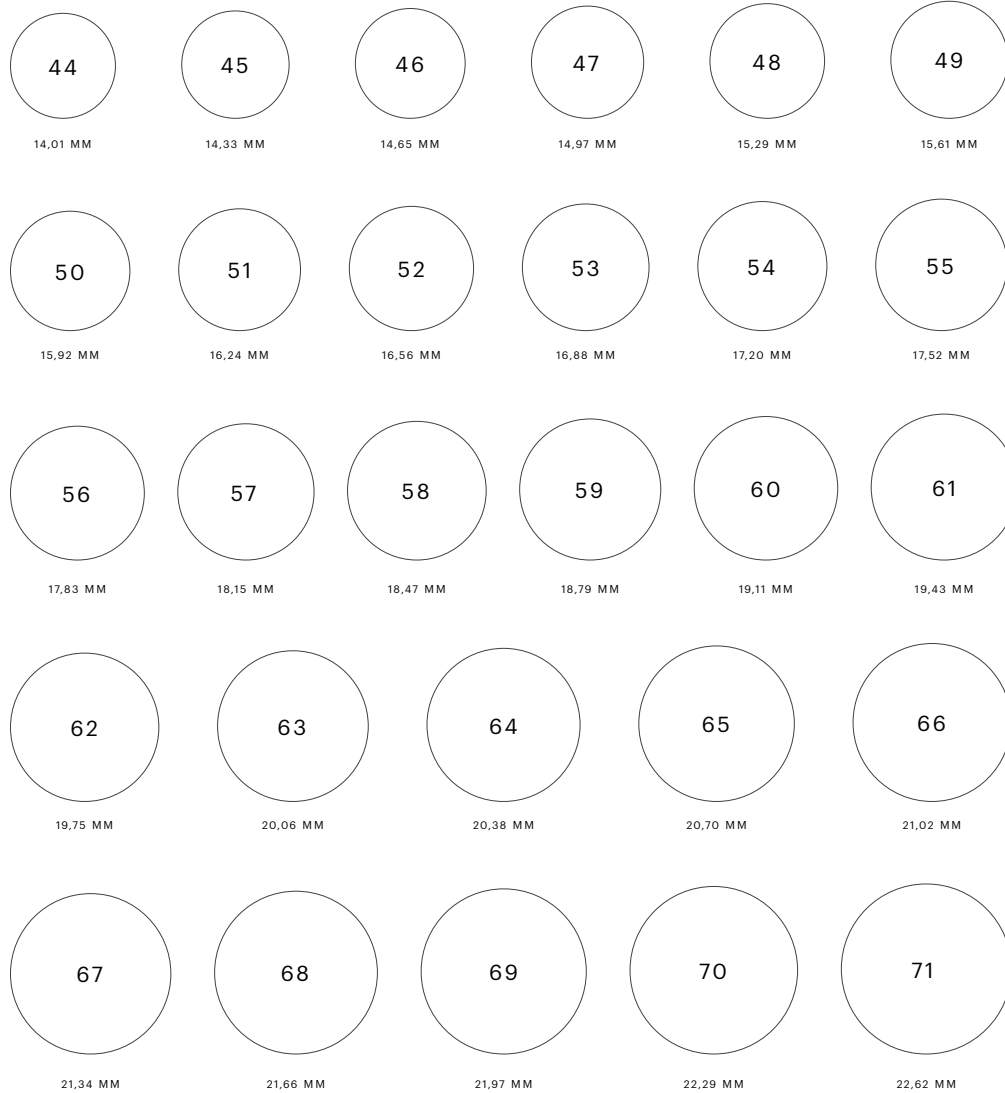

2. Select one of your rings (preferably a ring that is not very wide and is uniform such as an alliance type) that perfectly corresponds to the size of the finger in which you want to wear your new piece of jewelry. Be mindful, sizes can vary between one hand and the other.
3. Then place your ring in the circles below. The black circle should appear inside your ring, right next to the inner border (with no white background gaps). The number in the circle corresponds to your size.

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METHOD 3

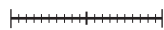
This method invites you to take your finger measurement using the tool below.

For a reliable measurement, we recommend that you measure your finger at the end of the day and avoid a time when your fingers are particularly cold.

Steps to follow:

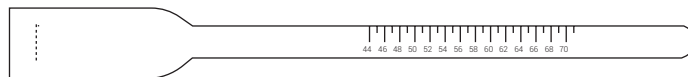
Print this document in A4 format and in full size (100% scale).

To make sure it's printed correctly, check the scale below with a ruler. It should measure exactly 2 cm.

- Cut the measuring ring along the lines and make a slot where indicated.
- Now wrap the measuring ring around your finger, making sure the numbers are clearly visible.
- Insert the tip into the opening and slide the resulting ring along your finger.
- Pull on the ring to fit the ring to your finger and determine its size. Your size appears in the opening.

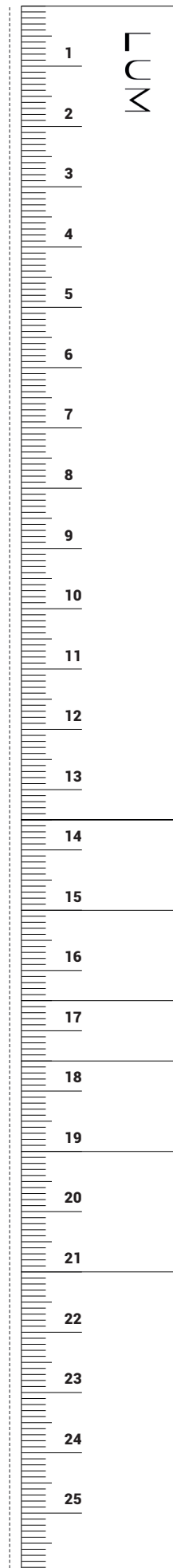

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MEASURING TAPE

To find out your size, print the measuring tape, and wrap it around your wrist loosely.

Attention, print at 100% scale and cut along the lines.



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CLOSED RIGID BRACELETS

Measure the widest part of the hand, imagining passing the bracelet in the hand.

Size S: circumference 18cm maximum

Size M: circumference 20cm maximum

Size L: circumference 21cm maximum

OPEN RIGID BRACELETS

Size S: wrist circumference: from 13 to 15cm

Size M: wrist circumference: from 15.5 to 17cm

Size L: wrist circumference: 17.5 to 19cm

Size XL: wrist circumference: 19 to 21cm.

NECKLACES WITH CHAINS

Take a tape, measure your neck at the level of the small gap between the 2 clavicles (in other words, at the base of the neck), loosely.

Size S (neck circumference 34 to 36cm): 40cm long

Size M (neck circumference from 37 to 39cm): 43cm long

Size L (neck circumference 40 to 42cm): 46cm long

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
